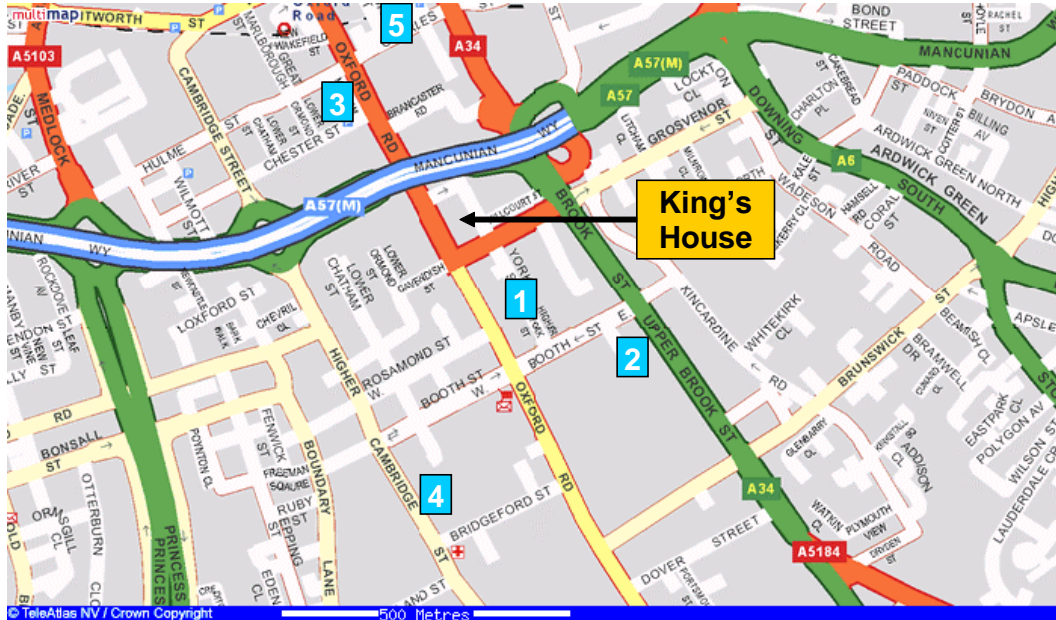


Map and Directions

On-Street Parking

There are free parking bays on Sidney Street that have a restriction of 2 hours on weekdays 8:00am to 6:00pm and on York Street 2 hours on weekdays 8:00am to 6:30pm and Saturdays 8:00am to 12:30pm.

Lower Ormond Street, Higher Ormond Street and Lower Chatham Street have similar 2 hour free parking bays with varying restrictions on Saturdays.

On weekdays after 6pm or 6:30pm, Saturdays after 12:30pm, Sundays and bank holidays, it is permissible to park on single yellow lines on Oxford Road, Grosvenor Street, Cavendish Street, Higher Ormond Street, Lower Ormond Street and Lower Chatham Street.

Please take great care to read the parking restriction signs if you park in any of the locations listed above.

By Train

Manchester Oxford Road train station is a 6 minute walk and the closest to King's House. From the station, turn right onto Whitworth Street then immediately right onto Oxford Road. Walk past the BBC, under the Mancunian Way flyover and take the first left into Sidney Street. Follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

Manchester Piccadilly train station is slightly further away. From the station, cross London Road then turn right onto Whitworth Street. Turn left onto Oxford Road by Manchester Oxford Road train station. Walk past the BBC, under the Mancunian Way flyover and then take the first left into Sidney Street. Follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance. It takes about 18 minutes to walk from Manchester Piccadilly train station. The alternative is to get bus 147 (Oxford Road Link) which runs every 10 minutes weekdays from the station and along Oxford Road.

For trains arriving at Manchester Victoria train station, it is best to get a bus to Piccadilly Gardens bus station and then change onto a bus going along Oxford Road (see by bus and coach section).

By Tram

There are Metrolink tram routes from Bury, Eccles and Altrincham. The closest Metrolink tram stop to King's House is St.Peter's Square and is a 10 minute walk. On arrival, turn onto Oxford Road, going away from the city centre. Walk past the BBC, under the Mancunian Way flyover and then take the first left into Sidney Street. Follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

By Bus

Oxford Road is a main bus corridor into the city centre with most routes ending at Piccadilly Gardens bus station. The closest stop heading away from the city centre is the Aquatics Centre and the closest stop heading into the city centre is All Saints' Park. The routes are as follows:

From Piccadilly Gardens via Oxford Road: 15 to Flixton. 16, 16A, 41 & 263 to Altrincham. 42 & 42A to Reddish & Stockport. 43 & 44 to Manchester Airport. 46, 47, 85 & 86 to Chorlton. 114, 250, 290 & 291 to the Trafford Centre. 111, 140 & 142 to East & West Didsbury. 143 to Northenden. 157 to Woodford. 253 to Partington.

From Piccadilly Gardens via Upper Brook Street: 130 to Macclesfield.

From Spring Gardens via Upper Brook Street: 50 to East Didsbury.

From Albert Square / Spring Gardens via Oxford Road: 46 & 47 to Chorlton. 42A & 197 to Reddish & Stockport. 191 to Poynton.

From Piccadilly Gardens via Higher Cambridge Street: 99 to Sale. 101, 104 & 109 to Wythenshawe. 256 to Flixton.

From Piccadilly Station via Oxford Road: 147 Oxford Road Link

By Coach

Manchester Central Coach Station is on Chorlton Street and is a 12 minute walk. On arrival turn right onto Sackville Street, left onto Portland Street and then left onto Oxford Road. Walk past the BBC, under the Mancunian Way flyover and then take the first left into Sidney Street. Follow the blue "King's Church" pedestrian signs round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

By Car

From the South (M6/M56)

Leave the M6 at Junction 19 and take the third exit from the roundabout signposted A556 Manchester. Continue on the A556 until the next roundabout, again taking the third exit, signposted M56 Manchester. Follow the M56 past Manchester Airport.

Beware at junction 3 where the M56 leaves the main carriageway and heads towards Stockport. Stay on the main carriageway towards Manchester city centre which becomes the A5103 (Princess Parkway, later Princess Road). Carry straight on for about 5 miles, passing a cemetery, playing fields & Shell garage on the left. Just before Royal Brewery on the right, turn right at a set of traffic lights onto Moss Lane East. Continue along Moss Lane East until a T-junction at the end of the park. Turn left onto Wilmslow Road which then becomes Oxford Road. Drive along Oxford Road and under a bridge by the University of Manchester. Carry on for about quarter of a mile then turn right at the last set of lights before the Mancunian Way flyover onto Sidney Street. Follow the road round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

From the North (M6/M61)

At junction 1 of the M61, join the M60 southbound (towards the airport). Leave the M60 at junction 12 and follow signs for the M602 (Salford). Continue to the end of the M602 and onto the A57 (Manchester city centre). Drive past a retail park and under a railway bridge onto the A57(M) Mancunian Way. Once on the A57(M) follow signs for A34 (Congleton) and leave the Mancunian Way taking a tight left turn into Sackville Street, keeping in the left lane. Turn left onto Upper Brook Street (A34) and then first right at the traffic lights (signposted "King's Church" and "Oxford Road") onto Grosvenor Street.

Drive along Grosvenor Street and turn right onto Oxford Road at the next set of lights by Barclays Bank. Turn right at the next set of lights (just before the Mancunian Way flyover) onto Sidney Street. Follow the road round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

From the East (M62)

At junction 18 the M62 becomes the M60. Leave the M60 motorway at junction 17, following signs for A56 (Prestwich). Stay on the A56 for about 3 miles. As you approach the city centre you will go under a railway bridge, passing the MEN Arena on your left. Continue into the city centre along Deansgate and then turn left onto A34 John Dalton Street (signposted "Central"). Go straight on through the next set of lights, continuing past the Town Hall onto Princess Street. Pass through several sets of lights and then under the A57(M) Mancunian Way, taking the first right at the lights, (signposted "King's Church" and "Oxford Road") onto Grosvenor Street.

Drive along Grosvenor Street and turn right onto Oxford Road at the next set of lights by Barclays Bank. Turn right at the next set of lights (just before the Mancunian Way flyover) onto Sidney Street. Follow the road round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.

From the West (M62)

Leave junction 12 of the M62 to join the M602 (Salford). Continue to the end of the M602 and onto the A57 (Manchester city centre). Drive past a retail park and under a railway bridge onto the A57(M) Mancunian Way. Once on the A57(M) follow signs for A34 (Congleton) and leave the Mancunian Way taking a tight left turn into Sackville Street, keeping in the left lane. Turn left onto Upper Brook Street (A34) and then first right at the traffic lights (signposted "King's Church" and "Oxford Road") onto Grosvenor Street.

Drive along Grosvenor Street and turn right onto Oxford Road at the next set of lights by Barclays Bank. Turn right at the next set of lights (just before the Mancunian Way flyover) onto Sidney Street. Follow the road round to the right and King's House is on the right, opposite Sugden Sports Centre main entrance.
